Frequently Asked Questions

Who may use the library?

College registrants have access to all library services. Please [contact the library](#) if you have any questions or concerns regarding access to services.

How do I request a literature search?

Use the [Literature Search Requests form](#) or email medlib@cpsbc.ca with your request.

How do I request an article?

Use the [Article Requests form](#) or email medlib@cpsbc.ca with your request.

Where should I start my search?

To search all library resources – go to the [Library homepage](#) search box.

For clinical summaries – go to the [Point of Care and Drug Tools](#) page.

To search the literature for journal articles – go to the [Databases](#) page.

To search for apps available to download – go to the [Apps and Audiovisual](#) page.

To search for ebooks and books available through the library – go to the [Catalogue](#).

What should I do if I am unable to log in?

Verify your CPSID and password. To create a new password, use the “Forgot my password” link on the [Login](#) page. Contact medlib@cpsbc.ca or call 604-733-6671 if the problem persists.

Do physicians have access to e-journals?

Yes. Search the list of e-journals held by the library on the [Books and Journals](#) page.

Do you have e-resources to download?

Yes. Some ebooks and e-resources are available to download to your device.

What is the loan period for books?

The initial loan period is three weeks and may be renewed to a maximum of three months if there are no holds placed upon the item.

How do I return borrowed books back to the library?

A return label is included with the book; attach the label to a padded envelope and drop it into a Canada Post mail box. Books may also be returned to the concierge at 669 Howe Street from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Can I suggest a book, e-resource or journal for purchase by the library?

Yes. Please send your suggestions to medlib@cpsbc.ca. We will review your request regarding availability and currency and let you know if the title will be included in the library’s holdings.
